

## MATERIALS




\*WARNING: Bleach is dangerous and extremely corrosive! Don't touch with bare hands, injest, inhale, or apply to anything delicate or precious.



## STEPS

Wearing gloves, mix 9 parts distilled water with 1 part bleach. For example mix 1 mL bleach with 9 mL distilled water and pour into your spray bottle using funnel.




Spray the glass, silverware, or surface you wish to remove residual DNA from thoroughly.



Let the bleach mixture sit up to 30 min.



Wipe the bleach spray off with a gloved hand.



Wipe remaining bleach residue away with clean water.
